



## Teller County Sheriff's Office Colorado Life Trak Caregiver Instructions

As participants in Colorado Life Trak, you, the caregiver, have certain responsibilities. These are:

1. Checks the transmitter once per day, with the provided tester, and record it on the tester sheet. This insures the transmitter is working.
2. If a problem exists, the band comes off, or the transmitter isn't indicating transmission, notify us immediately at 719-687-9652. Remember to sign and date the tester sheet.
3. If your loved one is missing, first check obvious places around your home. If you are unable to locate him/her, notify us immediately at **911**. If you are not home, be sure to give the telephone number where we may reach you and your code number. Tell them this is a Teller County Colorado Life Trak Client. **DO NOT CALL THE PERSON THAT VISITS YOU FOR BATTERY CHANGES.** They may be unavailable. Dispatch is there 24 hours a day.
4. **IMPORTANT!** If your loved one moves to another location, contact the program manager, Deputy Renee Bunting, at 719-687-9652, as we may be able to transfer him/her to another Colorado Life Trak Representative. If your loved one enters the hospital and the wrist band needs to be removed by healthcare providers, contact us and we will place it back on his/her wrist as soon as permitted.
