Are you eligible to register to vote?

Eligibility requirements

To be eligible to register to vote in Colorado you must be:

- A United States citizen
- A Colorado resident for at least 22 days before the election you intend to vote in
- Not currently serving a term of imprisonment for a felony conviction
- At least 15 years old. *But, you won't be eligible to vote until you are 18 years old.*

I have been arrested or convicted of a crime

You can vote if you are:

- On probation for either a misdemeanor or felony
- A pretrial detainee awaiting trial
- Currently in jail serving a misdemeanor sentence only
- No longer serving a term of imprisonment due to a felony conviction.

If you were incarcerated due to a felony conviction, you must re-register to vote.

I am between 15 and 17 years old

You can pre-register to vote in Colorado. Once you turn 18 years old, you can vote.

Form FAQ

Which ID do I have to provide?

If you have a Colorado Driver's License or Colorado ID card, you must provide that number.

If you don't have a Colorado Driver's License or Colorado ID card, you can provide the last 4 digits of your SSN.

If you don't have a Colorado Driver's License, Colorado ID card, or SSN, check the box. You may be required to provide an acceptable ID from the list on **[GoVoteColorado.gov](https://www.govotecolorado.gov)**.

Which address do I have to provide?

You must provide the address where you currently live. If you have another address where you receive mail or if you want to receive your ballot at another address, you must provide those addresses too.

Why do you ask for my email?

We ask for your email in case we have a question about your application or ballot, and so we can email you about upcoming elections. Your email is confidential.

Your ballot and other election mail will still be sent by regular mail.

What information is in the public record?

We don't share your sensitive information including your social security number, driver's license number, month and day of birth, signature, and email.

But, the other information on your application is public as required by law. You may be eligible to keep more of your voter information private. For details contact your county clerk and recorder.

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What happens next?

Thank you for registering to vote or updating your voter registration!

I am registering to vote for the first time in Colorado

We will process your application within 2 weeks of receiving it. We will mail you an official information card about 20 days after we receive your registration.

I am updating my Colorado voter registration record

You can check your status on the website [GoVoteColorado.gov](https://www.GoVoteColorado.gov) on the page “Find My Registration”.

I am between 15 and 17 years old and pre-registering to vote

We will mail you an official information card about 20 days after we receive your registration. You can check your status once you turn 18 years old.

Do I need ID to vote?

If you are voting by mail for the first time, you may need to provide a photocopy of your ID.

If you vote in person, you must show ID to vote. Find a list of acceptable forms of ID at [GoVoteColorado.gov](https://www.GoVoteColorado.gov).

What if I want to vote by mail?

All Colorado registered voters automatically receive ballots by mail.

To vote by mail in the next election, we must receive this application at least 8 days before Election Day. If we don't receive this application at least 8 days before Election Day, then you must vote in person. In every election after that, you will receive a ballot by mail.

What if I want to vote in person?

You can choose to vote in person at your county Voter Service and Polling Center in your county.

All voters who vote in person must provide ID. While there are many forms of acceptable ID, most voters find it convenient to bring their Colorado driver's license or Colorado ID. A Colorado ID is available at no cost to those who are eligible. Find the full list of acceptable ID at [GoVoteColorado.gov](https://www.GoVoteColorado.gov). For more information on obtaining a Colorado ID, please contact the Colorado Department of Revenue.

If I'm unaffiliated, can I vote in the primary election?

Yes. Unaffiliated voters are eligible to vote in the primary election. You can only vote in 1 party's primary election.

If I'm unaffiliated, can I participate in a party's caucus meeting?

No. To participate in a party caucus meeting you must join that party before the party's caucus. However, you are still eligible to vote in any participating party's primary election.

- I am at least 15 years old; and I understand that I must be at least 18 to be eligible to vote in any election.

I further affirm that the residence address I provided is my sole legal place of residence. I certify under penalty of perjury that the information I have provided on this application is true to the best of my knowledge and belief; and that I have not, nor will I, cast more than one ballot in any election.
